ABATE of Ohio and it's staff does not make anything from this event although it is a not-for-profit organization 501(c) 4 charity. All start up monies are gathered from sponsors and vendors. Although given discounts, the event still incurs a significant amount of overhead for items and services necessary to facilitate the event.

This is a rain or shine event, shelter will be available.

**This is an adult only event. No one under 21 admitted.**

Ticket cost is \$30 in advance and at gate and is non-refundable.

**Patron must retain ticket.** Number is matched for shirt order. Ticket is punched upon entry for weekend wrist band, food, and upon receiving pre-registered t-shirt if applicable. Ticket includes 2 day entry, half chicken dinner, primitive camping (RV's allowed self contained) bike show and bike game entry.

Ticket also **includes T-shirt only if sold and registered before August 1<sup>st</sup>**. They are to be claimed at event or by calling 419-307-3506 with-in 30 days following.

**Everyone entering event premises must sign insurance waiver- no exceptions.**

The gates open for the event on Friday, Aug. 19<sup>th</sup> 12 noon with entertainment starting at 6 pm until midnight.

Entertainment starts on Saturday at noon until midnight with a break from 5-7 pm.

Chicken dinner served from 3-6 pm Saturday.

\$1000 poker run is from 9 am - 5 pm, last bike out at 1pm (\$10 fee per entry)

Bike show Saturday , 2 pm -- bike show - free registration until 3 pm

- judging 3:00 pm - 4:00 pm

Bike games 5 pm- free registration

Additional food vendors and ice sales available on site. Coolers welcome, bring lawn chair if possible.

Sorry- **Campfires are not allowed.** There may be a community bonfire at the event maintained by staff where event patrons may gather.

Motor vehicles will not be permitted at campsite unless parked for the entire duration of event attendance. (excluding motorcycles)

No dumping of waste solids or fluids.

No pets, ATVs, firearms, weapons, fireworks, glass, nor threatening attitudes of any kind.
